- Promote your event and share content about #CEweek2026 on your website and where available with your network.

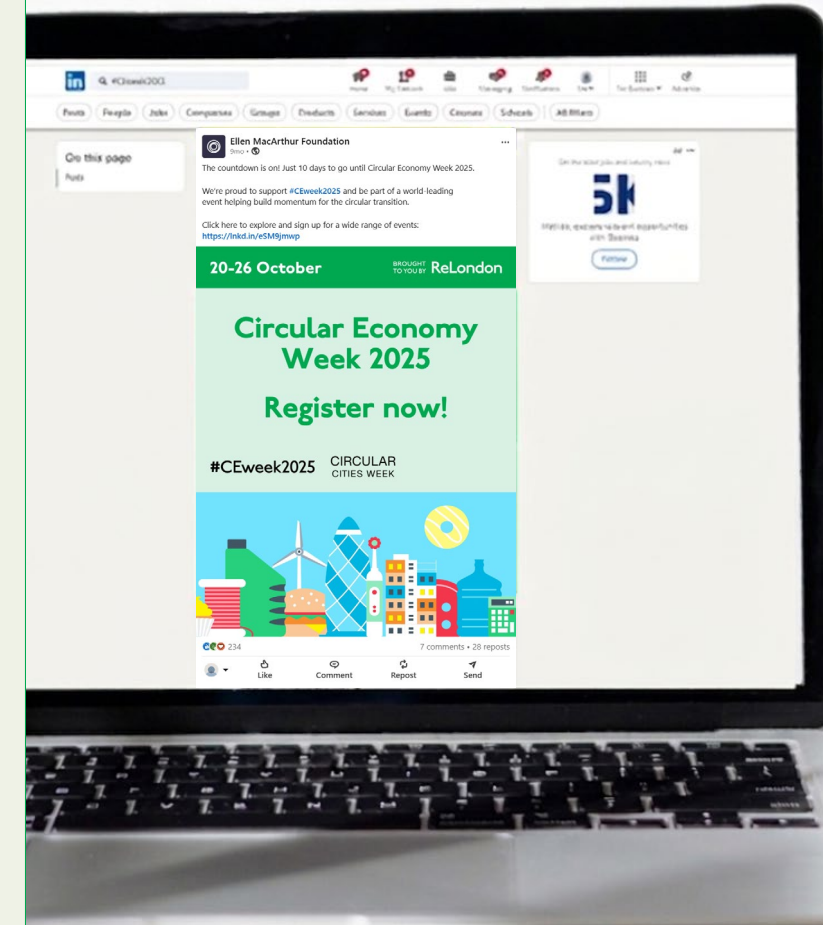
